3. Mezquita (Mosque) Al-Ahmad. Alberti 1541. Tel. 4941-6994. Inaugurated in 1985, this is the first mosque with Islamic architecture in Argentina, designed by Ahmed and Elia Ham. The best day to visit is Friday at midday when the Imam gives his most important weekly sermon.

The complex also contains a library, an exhibition centre, an auditorium and several classrooms where Arabic lessons are offered. It also contains the Colegio Rey Fahd (Cerviño 4851), a primary and secondary school.
